COMMUNITY GRANTS

Community Grant Scheme

Bishton Community Council, which covers Underwood, Bishton and Wilcrick, has decided to continue with grants to voluntary groups and initiatives in our area for projects benefiting the local community. Community Grants are intended to support new or expanded initiatives rather than everyday housekeeping costs. They can cover any section of the community including children, adults, pensioners, the disabled and disadvantaged people.

<u>Criteria</u>

This scheme was introduced in 2017-18 and will continue for the foreseeable future. As before, we are going to be flexible in our approach and follow three key principles:

1. The grant must benefit the local community (or part of it);

2. The grant will only be provided to voluntary and not-for-profit projects in Underwood, Bishton or Wilcrick; and

3. If a grant is made to a church, it cannot be used for building maintenance.

Applications

Please send applications in the form of a short letter or email giving these details:

- 1. Name of group applying for the grant.
- 2. Membership and status of the group.
- 3. Project for which a grant is sought, including objectives, any co-funding, timescale, and bank account details.
- 4. Contact details of the group official or member who would take responsibility for receiving the grant, ensuring it was properly spent, and providing a report to the Council.

The closing date for applications is 28 February each year.

Selection and Reporting

The Council will decide which applications it can support on a case-by-case basis.

Successful applicants will be asked to submit a short report on the use of the grant and if possible provide photographs for our website.
